Proboscis Monkeys are perhaps one of the world's most distinctive mammals, with a fleshy and long nose that males use to attract mates. It is believed that the size of the nose creates an echo chamber that amplifies the monkey's call, which intimidates rival males and im-

presses females. Unfortunately, Proboscis monkeys are in great danger because of the threatened landscapes where forests are being cleared for timber and oil palm plantations, greatly affecting their habitat.

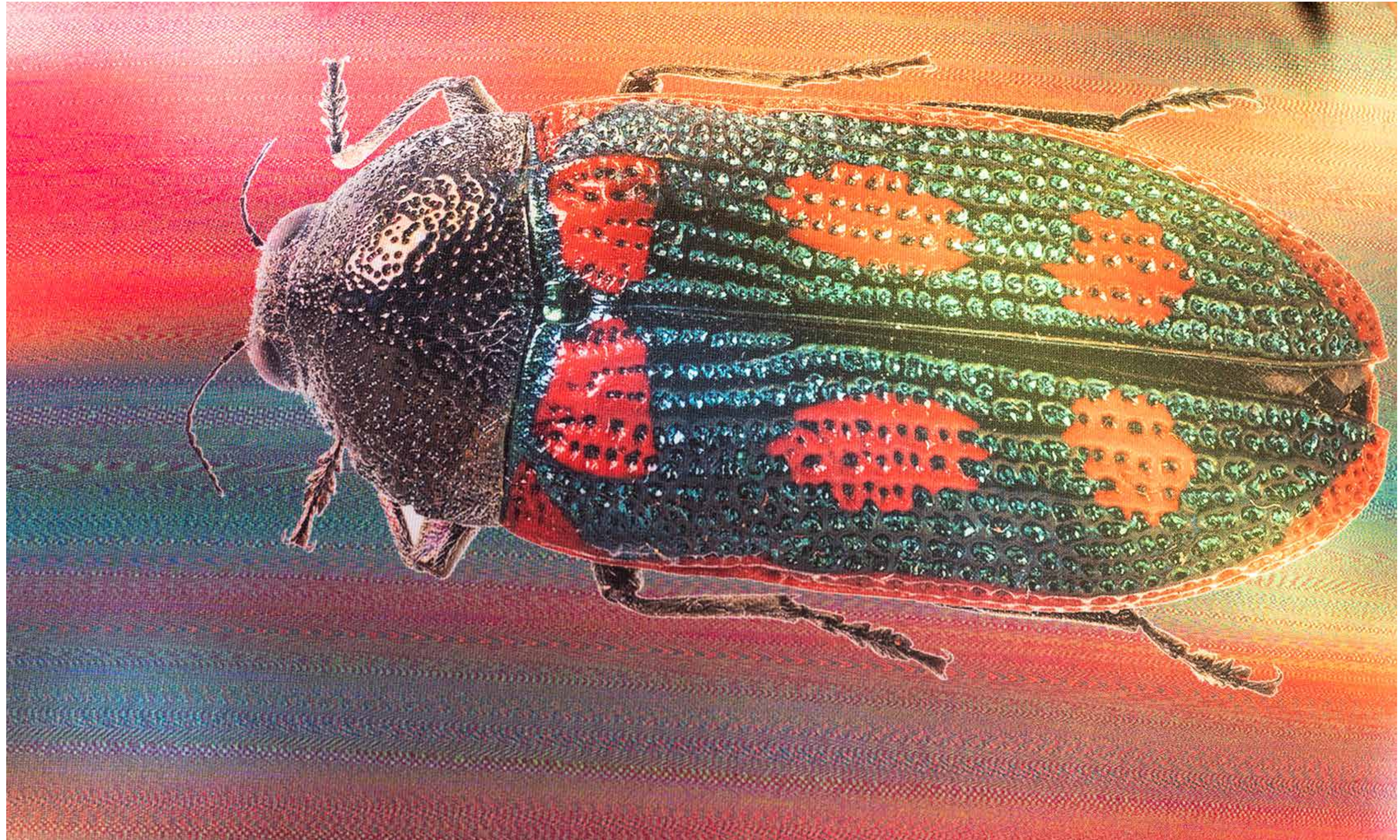
The Surinamese Toads or Pipa Pipa are a species of frogs that are wide and very flat, with a triangle-shaped head. They inhabit eastern South America and Trinidad. When Surinamese toads reproduce they perform an elegant swim, where the females release eggs, which then

the males fertilize. Males then carefully place the fertilized eggs on the females' back and the eggs sink into the skin, where the young toads grow until they burst through the skin as froglets.

Hammerhead Sharks are aggressive hunters to be reckoned with. Their oddly shaped hammer-like heads allow for quicker movement and panoramic vision to give them a better visual range than most other sharks. Hammerheads' sensory organs are spread over their

wide head so that they can scan the ocean for food more thoroughly. Hammerheads' increased sensitivity allows them even to find their favorite meal, stingrays, which usually bury themselves under the sand.

Platypuses are perhaps the most confusing animal on Earth to humans. When they were discovered, naturalists thought it was some kind of fake and that taxidermists had gotten creative and sewn the bill of a duck on some sort of beaver-like creature and added webbed

feet for grins. Only found in eastern Australia and Tasmania, platypuses are egg-laying mammals with very unusual sex chromosomes: Male platypuses have five X chromosomes and five Y chromosomes.

Tardigrades, also known as moss piglets or water bears, are microscopic bear-like animals with eight legs that have been on Earth for about 600 million years, and would most likely survive the apocalypse. Tardigrades belong to a category of animals called extremophiles, or

living creatures that can survive extreme environments. They can go for 30 years without food or water, live at temperatures as cold as absolute zero or above boiling, and at pressures of deepest waters or the vacuum of outer space.

According to an Aztec legend, the Axolotl is the god of lightning and fire Xolotl, who turned himself into a salamander to avoid being sacrificed. Despite the legend, these Mexican amphibians have fascinating qualities on their own, such as the ability to regenerate lost or

damaged limbs, hearts, spinal cords, and even parts of their brains, without any scars. Because scarring stops tissue from regenerating, finding out why axolotls don't scar could help humans learn how to regenerate tissue as well.

Banana Slugs are named for their resemblance to a ripe banana. Banana slugs are hermaphrodites — they are both male and female at the same time. At the time of mating, one or both of the slugs may become pregnant. In extreme cases, slugs can make themselves pregnant,

which is very uncommon as it is an extreme form of inbreeding with no mixing of genes from different parents. They are one of the slowest creatures on Earth, moving at a max-speed of about 16 centimeters per minute. They only have one foot, one lung, and no spine.
